Proposed USCIS Fee Increases

A new proposed U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) rule would significantly increase fees for immigrants.

Here's what it would do:

 Increase the naturalization application fee to \$1,170

An 83% increase from the current fee of \$640



Eliminate existing fee waivers

This would require almost all applicants to pay the full \$1,170 naturalization fee.



Add a new \$275 fee for DACA

This would increase the total DACA fee to \$765.



USCIS published the new proposed rule on Nov. 14, providing 30 days for public comments.

The fee increases are likely to be enacted as early as Feb. 2020.
